Language Class (Nihongo or English)

Let's learn more about Japanese Traditions

Children will learn and experience many traditional activities of Japanese culture. During the tea ceremony class (茶道), they will start with the basic rules and proper manner using the authentic materials, and at the end older children will learn to serve the tea. In the Calligraphy class (書道), the first step will be to get used to the brushes and then learn the brush strokes with proper posture. Those actual experiences will enrich their vocabulary since they hear many words that they don't often encounter in language lessons.
